He Stood In Your Place

What if you should do something terribly wrong and are waiting to be punished, but then someone steps in your place and decides that he or she will face the punishment on your behalf? Wouldn't that be an awesome gesture? Well, you are favored by a loving God, and that's the grace that He has extended to you when He sends His only son to die in your place. You should've faced the penalty of sin:

But he was pierced for our transgressions, he was crushed for our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace was on him, and by his wounds we are healed. (Isaiah 53:5) NIV

What did Jesus endure as He stood in your place?
