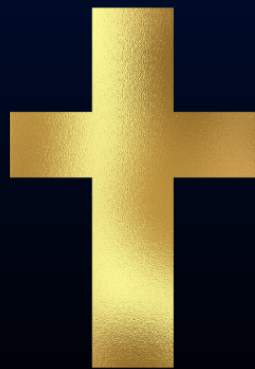

Prayer: Thank You Lord for Your provision. I know that You are faithful. I know that just as You have provided for others, You provide for me. In Jesus' Name, I pray. Amen.

Journal Prompt: To ultimately know God as Jehovah Jireh, Abraham had to choose obedience to God over his beloved son.

Have you ever been faced with a choice between holding on to your provision (job, finances, relationship, etc.) and obeying the God Who Provides? What choice did you make?

Prayer: Lord, there are times when I am so focused on the blessings that I don't acknowledge You, the One who blesses me. I recognize this as a sign of fear that I will lose the blessing. I turn my focus to You and acknowledge that You are the source of all my blessings. Amen.

Journal Prompt: "If any of you lacks wisdom, you should ask God, who gives generously to all without finding fault, and it will be given to you." - James 1:5 NIV

What is a book that has impacted your spiritual growth? How did God give you new wisdom and insight through the book?

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Prayer: Dear God, I place my trust and faith in You in every situation. Bless me with your divine wisdom. Amen.

Journal Prompt: Because of the Lord's great love we are not consumed, for his compassions never fail. They are new every morning; great is your faithfulness." - Lamentations 3:22-23 NIV

What part of waking up every morning are you most thankful for? Why?

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Prayer: Prayer: Lord, Your mercies are new every morning! How great is Your faithfulness to me! This is the day You have made and I will rejoice and be glad in it! In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Journal Prompt: For no matter how much they used, there was always plenty left in the containers, just as the Lord had promised through Elijah!" - 1 Kings 17:16 NIV

God's provision never runs out. Reflect on a time when God provided more than you needed.

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Prayer: Thank You God for the abundance of blessings You have already stored up for me. I trust You today, and every day, to provide for me. Amen.

Journal Prompt: "And my God will meet all your needs according to the riches of his glory in Christ Jesus." - Philippians 4:19 NIV

What do you need? Make a list of every need that comes to your mind. At the bottom of your list, write out Philippians 4:19—"And my God will meet all your needs according to the riches of his glory in Christ Jesus."

Prayer: Dear Lord, my God, I put my needs in Your hands today. I stand in faith as I remember that You are Jehovah Jireh, You will provide for my every need. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Prayer: Dear God, You know my deepest desires—even those I've held in secret. I open my heart today and give them to You. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Journal Prompt: Yet the LORD longs to be gracious to you; therefore he will rise up to show you compassion." - Isaiah 30:18, NIV

Take a moment to carefully read Isaiah 30:18. How does it feel to know that God wants to bless you? How does this revelation change the prayers you've been praying?

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Prayer: Father, thank You that You are the all-powerful God who longs to be gracious to me and show me compassion. Thank You that it is Your pleasure to give me good things. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Journal Prompt: Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls." - Matthew 11:28-29 NIV

What's weighing you down? Write to God today about anything that's concerning you. Share your thoughts with the Lord and declare that your needs are met.

Journal Prompt: Consider the ravens: They do not sow or reap, they have no storeroom or barn; yet God feeds them. And how much more valuable you are than birds!' - Luke 12:24 NIV

You are valuable to God. Make a list of all the ways God has shown you how much He cares for you this week.

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Prayer: Lord, when I am tempted to be anxious and worry, help me to remember how much You care for me. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Journal Prompt: "He who did not spare his own Son, but gave him up for us all—how will he not also, along with him, graciously give us all things?" - Romans 8:32 NIV

Read and reflect on Romans 8:32. What encouragement does God provide to you in this verse?

Prayer: God, I thank You for who You are to me—my Father, my Lord, my Provider. Amen.

Journal Prompt: Your love has given me great joy and encouragement, because you, brother, have refreshed the hearts of the Lord's people." - Philemon 1:7 NIV

Have you ever received help from a person or organization? How did God use them to bless you and provide for your needs?

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Prayer: Dear God, I thank You for the people in my life who support and encourage me. Thank You for using them to bless me. Please also use me to be a conduit of Your blessings and favor to others. Amen.

Journal Prompt: Many are the plans in a person's heart, but it is the Lord's purpose that prevails." - Proverbs 19:21 NIV

Most of us think we would be happier if we had or gained something more. But often when God says no, it's for His glory and for His greater purpose.

Reflect on the lessons God taught you by saying no or by closing a door in your life.

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Prayer: Lord, I thank You for Your wisdom. I thank You for keeping me away from temptation and delivering me from things that would take me out of Your will for my life. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Journal Prompt: May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace as you trust in him, so that you may overflow with hope by the power of the Holy Spirit." - Romans 15:13 NIV

What's an area in your life where you are doubting God's provision? Write a prayer asking God to fill you with hope.

Prayer: Lord, You know the things in my heart that I barely dare hope for. I give them to You. Fill me with hope and give me a tangible reminder today of Your love and provision. In Jesus' Name, Amen.
