What's an area in your life where you are doubting God's provision? Write a prayer asking God to fill you with hope.
<b>Prayer:</b> Lord, You know the things in my heart that I barely dare hope for. I give them to You. Fill me with hope and give me a tangible reminder today of Your love and provision. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

<b>Journal Prompt:</b> Our mistakes don't stop God's provision. The Bible is full of people who majorly messed up, but God still helped them do amazing things.
Reflect on your favorite Bible character who "messed up." How did God provide for them?
How does their story encourage you?
